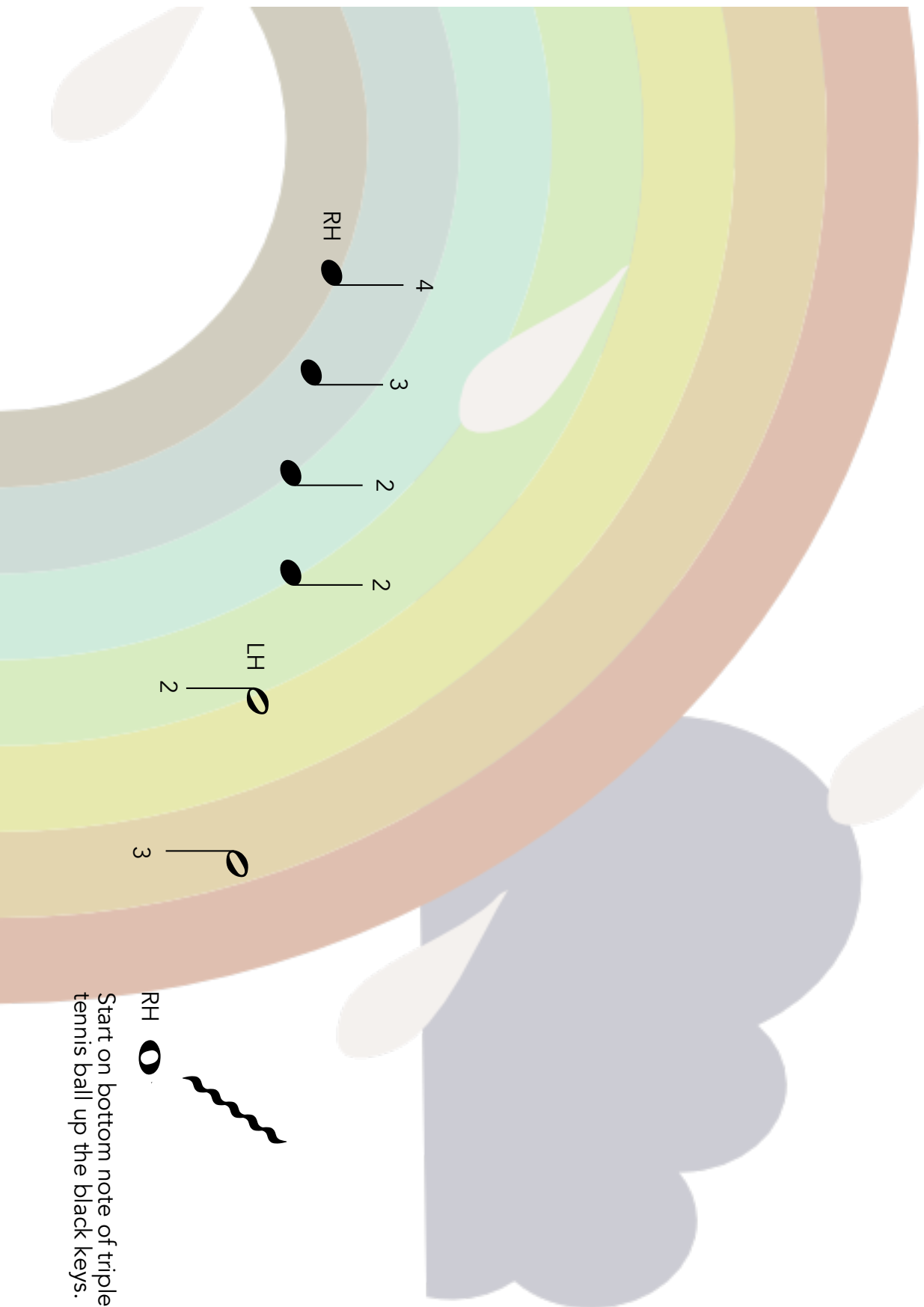
Hold right pedal throughout piece.
